2008 QUEENSLAND REDISTRIBUTION

This document analyses the 2006 State election results within the context of new electoral boundaries gazetted on 20 August 2008.

While the total number of seats remains at 89, three new seats have been created in south east Queensland – Buderim (Sunshine Coast), Coomera (Gold Coast) and Morayfield (Caboolture area).

Two seats have been merged in north Queensland – Charters Towers (NP) and Tablelands (One Nation) – to form the new seat of Dalrymple. Two seats in the southern inland have been merged – Cunningham (NP) and Darling Downs (NP) – to form the new seat of Condamine.

One seat in central Queensland – Fitzroy (ALP) – has been abolished.

There are eight new names among the 89 seats – three new seats and five with name changes:

The boundaries of Moggill (Lib) remain unchanged.

Two-party preferred votes have been calculated for all 89 seats in accordance with the methodology set out in my *Statistical Analysis* of the 2006 State Election. Accordingly, all seats have been reduced to ALP – National/Liberal contests with minor party and independent preferences distributed between the Government and Opposition where appropriate.

As a consequence of the creation of the Liberal National Party in 2008 I have adopted the terminology “LNP” where appropriate.

On 5 October 2008 Ronan Lee (ALP, Indooroopilly) joined the Greens. However, as Lee was elected as a member of the ALP in 2006 I am treating Indooroopilly as a Labor seat.
